Summary:

The International Festival of Women Artists Collection documents the planning, execution, and outcome of the International Festival of Women Artists. The Festival, which brought together women artists from more than 30 countries, was held at the NY Carlsberg Glyptotek Museum in Copenhagen, Denmark. It provided a community where the artists could share their creative work and a platform to address issues of the women's art movement. In addition to administrative papers, the collection also includes objects and documents from the event itself.

Processing Note:

The Copenhagen and Nairobi finding aids were prepared and collection processed by Mary Oliver Humke in 1994. The Beijing finding aid was prepared and collection processed in 1998. The collections were further processed and finding aids updated in 2014 by Rebecca Quon. Subsequent LRC support provided in 2017 to create an overarching finding aid under the title UN World Conferences on Women which would have served as the umbrella

finding aid to the three collection series. Series 1: International Festival of Women Artists (Copenhagen, Denmark). Series 2: Focus International (Nairobi, Kenya). Series 3: Global Focus (Beijing, China). It is unclear why an overarching finding aid was never created. A re-evaluation of the collections and their inventories led to the 2020 decision to keep the collections separate in order to maintain proper records of provenance and ensure usability for researchers. To this end, a new set of finding aids was created by Emily Moore in April of 2020.

Historical Note

The International Festival of Women Artists was held at the NY Carlsberg Glyptotek Museum in Copenhagen, Denmark from July 14-30, 1980. It took place in conjunction with the World Conference of the United Nations' Decade for Women, and was sponsored by the Coalition of Women's Arts Organizations. The Festival brought together female artists from more than 30 countries, providing a community in which they could share their diverse creative work and freely explore various issues of the women's art movement. Funding for the United States participants was provided by the State Department through the International Communications Agency. Events included literary readings, films, videos, a continuous slideshow of artwork, performances, panel discussions, and exhibitions of artwork.

Scope and Content Note

The collection on the International Festival of Women Artists documents the event from its beginning stages, in 1979, to post-festival activities in 1983. It contains the correspondence of Festival coordinators with the United States and Danish embassies, American and Danish women artists, the UN, the White House, and the Glyptotek in Copenhagen. Other documents related to Festival planning include letters soliciting support for the Festival, financial statements, and grant application for the National Endowment for the Arts.

Many objects have been saved from the Festival itself: exhibition guides, banners, lecture transcriptions, photographs, and other materials that document the festival. Clippings from newspapers preserve contemporary press coverage, and there are fifteen audiotapes documenting various events at the Festival. The archives house the international collection of postcards submitted by artists and displayed at the festival. They were created in a variety of media: paintings, drawings, prints, photographs, collages, and mixed

media. There are fifteen audiotapes documenting the project. Posters from the Festival are located in the flat files of the LRC map case.

As a whole, these documents and objects create a comprehensive record of the International Festival of Women Artists from start to finish and give a unique look into the administrative process behind planning such a large-scale event. They also give insight into the international women's rights movement of the late 1970s and early 1980s, and the UN's policies and programs to advance the status of women during the same period.
